Policies and Procedures

Joining: The BATO Dance Studio Corporation is a year-round program. The age requirement is 3 to 15 boys and girls that have the means of transportation.

Commitment: Students are to commit to giving their all-in dance, academics, activities, cooperation and participation.

Registration: The Registration Fee is \$25 per student which is nonrefundable and covers the offset cost of administration fees and community awareness activities. The Registration Fee must be paid promptly in advance before he or she can begin their first class.

Auditions: All auditions are conducted before every dance routine to reassure the placement of each child and their abilities. Every child is given an equal opportunity and chance to excel in dance at their own pace.

Payment Policy Late Fees/Bounce Checks /Non-Payment: The Monthly/Yearly/Tuition Fee varies per student. All fees are due on or before the 4th of each month. A duration period of the 15th will act as a deadline to pay tuition. If tuition is not paid by the 15th of each month an additional \$25 late fee will be added to tuition fee. If a check bounces a \$35 charge is due to be added to your account for insufficient funds. Do good to keep record of all receipts and paperwork received from the Organization Personnel. Be sure to make all payments payable to only the BATO Dance Studio Corporation. We only except check, cash, and debit card as a form of payment.

Departure: We do ask if you decide to move or withdraw your child, you must give a written two-week notification to notify the Organization and Personnel of such actions. If you leave without notice you are dismissed from returning to the team due to your actions of no notice of action.

On Time: Parents have your child to practice on time for the sake of starting Dance Class promptly and on schedule. All parents have a 10-minute duration period before practice starts before child is considered late and given additional warm-ups and extra exercise for tardiness.

Attendance: Attendance is mandatory and will be taken at every class. Please note that your child can only miss up to 3 classes, anything after that will result in the child not participating in upcoming events or performances. Practice Day's must be made up unless otherwise noted by Physician/Doctor.

Parents/Student: Please Sign In/Sign Out students 4 years and under: Please be aware that we're very concerned about the safety of every Student. It is important that you follow the Sign In and Sign Out rule to ensure that you are aware of the location of your child at the time of their scheduled drop off and pick up time for dance class.

Practice at Home: Practicing at home will help your child stay caught up with the choreography and routines given in dance class. Continue to encourage your child to eat the right foods for this will ensure the child is healthy and ready to perform or practice when needed.

Sickness: If a child becomes sick at any practices or performances, the parent or guardian will be called immediately. If the child is already sick, we encourage the parent to keep the child at home to seek medical attention.

Attitudes/Obedient: Dancer's must maintain a positive and encouraging attitude at all practices and events. There is to be no foul language or inappropriate gestures at any time by any member of the dance team. If this happens, an adult, dance instructor or staff personnel will be notified. Unlike sportsmanship to the dance instructors, dancers or any authority figure is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.

Observation: All parents are to remain in the waiting area during practice unless otherwise instructed by Dance Teacher or Staff Personnel.

Parent Involvement: It is essential that all parents be involved and attends all events, meetings, fundraisers, performances, and any other activity. Please check your text messages, emails, and social media regularly for any updates or news.

Dress Code and Attire for Girls and Boys at Practice: All boys and girls with long hair should wear hair in a ponytail. The attire for both the girls and boys are tank tops, t-shirts, sweatpants, legging, ballet shoes or sneakers; these items are comfortable, appropriate and are acceptable. Please make sure your clothing is loose and will not drag the ground.

Dress Code and Attire for Girls and Boys for Performances: Parents will be responsible for all uniforms purchases for their students. There will be inspections of your child's uniform before all activities. Any dancer who does not have all his or her uniform attire cannot participate in activities. Parents are responsible for replacing any uniform attire that is currently missing. Girls and Boys may only wear small earrings. Boys and Girls hair should be neat and fixed appropriately for all activities. Fingernail polish can only be worn if the proper approval has been given in advance.

Hygiene: Our students' appearance, hygiene, and the way they carry themselves are essential. Over time Student's hygiene changes drastically over time. Here we care about each other. We are asking that every parent be sure to take time out and have a private discussion with your child about their hygiene before every dance practice, performance, and any activities we may have.

Cell Phones: The use of cell phones during practice is strictly prohibited, in the case of an emergency Parents will be notified by Dance Teacher or Staff Personnel. All cell phones must be left with parents.

Injuries: Please be mindful that we are not responsible for any injuries that your child may occur during practices and or performances. Doctor's notes will be accepted if your child has accrued an injury and cannot participate in an upcoming practice or performance. All Parents or Guardians are asked to please provide Health Insurance information on your child's medical form during the registration process.

Dance Exercises: Exercises are tools meant to help stretch, relax muscles, and release stress in joints that helps strengthen and provide flexibility. Exercise also regulates the heart which helps build stamina. Please ensure your child is exercising regularly.

COVID Restrictions: If you or child is displaying any fever, coughing, headache, body pain, diarrhea, stomach pain, please go to the nearest Urgent Care Facility or see your current Physician. To return to the Team a written note from your Physician must be given to convey the steps to return, to keep everyone safe.

Cancellations and Closings: The Organization will make parents and staff aware of any inclement weather, emergencies or anything that may present to be problematic that may prohibit practice or any upcoming performance activities.

Toys/Weapons/Sharp Items/Food/Drink: All toys are prohibited in dance class as they present to be a distraction to all dancers. All food, gum, candy, etc. are also prohibited in dance class as these items are hazardous and a choking hazard if consumed while dancing. Any weapons or sharp items are prohibited in the facility as these items are a danger to anyone that may come in direct contact with them and can hinder the safety of all students, teachers, and personnel.

- Wed: 6:00pm-8:00pm,
- Thurs: By Appointment Only
- Fri: By Appointment Only

Code of Conduct

All disciplinary actions are as follows:

1. Being untruthful, dishonest, and deceitful.

If the student's behavior escalates, the following immediate actions will be subject to take place.

- a. **1st Warning:** Written notification will be sent to the parent/guardian with the nature of the unacceptable behavior the student exhibited. A signed copy of this notice must be returned to the dance team.
- b. **2nd Warning:** Should a second warning be necessary; the parents will be called to pick up their child immediately.
- c. **Dismissal:** Student is now terminated from the remainder of the BATO Dance Studio Corporation with no refund.
